Skin Contact	Take off contaminated clothing. Flush immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.
Inhalation	If breathing is difficult: Remove to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance and then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth to mouth, if possible. Get medical attention immediately.
Ingestion	Call medical attendant, doctor, or poison control center immediately. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
Notes to Physician	Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
